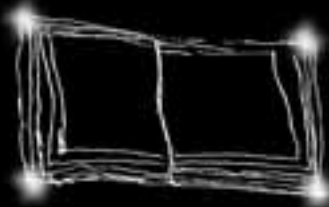

# Rainbow Driving for Safe, New Vans in 2007

In 2007, Rainbow Acres once again has set a high priority on securing, safe, reliable transportation for the Ranchers. Although great strides have been made in improving the Rainbow fleet, there are still high-mileage vehicles that need to be replaced. Every week, there are Ranchers to get to and from work and medical appointments and outings that require transportation. In addition, there are airport runs and Special Olympics! And in every instance, the cargo in our vehicles is precious and irreplaceable!

That's why Rainbow once again is participating in a special grant program of the **Arizona Department of Transportation** (ADOT). Rainbow has set a goal of five new vans from this program for 2007, and needs to raise \$50,000 to obtain them (this represents 20% of the actual cost, with ADOT supplying 80%).

So far, Evergreen Baptist Church in Rosemead, California has led the way with a \$10,000 mission gift for these new vans. The Rev. Dr. Ken Fong is the senior pastor of this thriving Asian-American church that reaches thousands with the Gospel every week.

Rainbow has to date raised \$30,000 of its \$50,000 goal. Individuals, churches, and organizations that have contributed so far are listed below, as are supporters from our 2006 van effort.

# Arizona Tax Credit Helps The Ranchers!

The need is great! Currently, 29 Ranchers are in need of financial aid. The Rainbow Board has budgeted a total of \$250,000 to help these Ranchers with their fees, and we must meet that goal! Your use of this tax credit will help tremendously in securing a brighter and better future for the Ranchers. Please consider using this credit when you file your Arizona return.

**The Credit for Contributions to Charities That Provide Assistance to the Working Poor** is made possible under Arizona law ARS-1088. This allows you to direct up to \$200 of your total Arizona income tax liability to Rainbow (if filing as "single" or "head of household"), or up to \$400 if filing as married. To take this credit, send the credit amount you want to claim directly to Rainbow Acres and use Arizona tax form 321 when you file your return.

Certain restrictions and exclusions apply to this tax credit, so consult your tax advisor prior to using it.
