Chou holds an M.S. from Juilliard, a D.M.A. in Piano Performance from the University of Southern California and a M. Div. from Duke Divinity School. For over two decades, she taught university level music at Nyack College in New York, Silliman University in the Philippines, Soochow University and Tunghai University, both in Taiwan. As a performer, Chou appeared in major venues across the United States and Southeast Asia, including Tchaikovsky Hall in Moscow, Hong Kong City Hall and the Chicago Cultural Center. During her time overseas, Chou and her husband served as missionaries for the United Presbyterian Church. Dr. Chou recently retired from ministry in the Los Angeles area and moved to Sedona with her husband.
