In addition to social opportunities and vocational training benefits, this program will enable participants to adjust to the ranch, the staff and the other residents before transitioning to the comprehensive care program.

At Rainbow Acres, vocational training plays an important role in the lives of the residents. Residents attend daily small group sessions in which they receive vocational instruction and experience in one or more of a variety of specialties including landscaping, weaving, painting, equine care and more. Morning program participants will benefit from this vocational training, as well as take part in social activities with other residents. The morning program will conclude with lunch in the new, state-of-the-art Palmer Community Center.
